Fri 9th Aug

Swimming & BBQ (+LB) @St Thomas Bay-near kiosk

1530-2100hrs

Parents should get cubs at the meeting point and pick them up from the same place.

Boys should come ready with their swimming trunks and activity t- shirt and girls should wear their swimsuit beneath their activity wear (no bikinis allowed). Money can be brought for an ice-cream!

No need for scarf today as we might lose it and instead of activity cap cubs can wear a sun hat (straw hat or fisherman's hat). Sunblock should be applied from home before the activity and brought in the backpack just in case we need a re-application.

Consent Form should be brought today and on it parents should write if cubs need any swimming aids. When we say swimming aids we refer to help which the cub needs to swim like trainers or noodle and not any other equipment brought for fun like board, goggles, etc. Please do not get any other equipment with you as you will have each other's company to play in the water and we can organise some games for you.

In their backpack cubs should get the following:

Enough water to drink

Sunblock

Small cooler bag with food to cook like burgers, chicken nuggets or sausages (Please give the cub the amount which he or she eats and not a whole packet as we see a lot of food going to waste); a bun or roll (for burger or hotdog whatever) and some healthy salad; Cutlery bag (and all it should contain)

Money for ice-cream (in a small wallet)

When parents get the cubs at 3.30pm or when they pick them up at 9pm they should book for the activity we have on <u>Thursday</u> **22nd August at the National Acquarium by getting Consent Form and fee in an envelope with the cub's name** - details in this circular

Those cubs who either do not book today or who cannot make it today but did not advise us about their attendance on the 22nd August will be taken as not attending.

Since beavers cannot attend swimming activities until they become cubs and hence cannot attend this meeting, booking for the activity on the 22nd should be made by a comment left in the reminder post of this activity which is done mid week (i.e. on Wed 07 Aug) by Bagheera. Then they should get Consent Form and payment on the day.

Visit to National Acquarium (+LB) & (+MOB) @Bulebel
