Dear Parents

On Saturday 2nd June (Rama's Joint Activity) we have two bookings - for the Father & Cub Activity and for the Pack Camp. Since there are 2 bookings, parents are kindly requested to put these **2 bookings into 2 seperate envelopes** which are marked on the outside with the cubs's name and the name of the activity for which the booking is being made. No consent form is needed for the Father & Cub activity - fee only; whilst for the Pack Camp the special Consent Form given to cubs on the 26th May should be used (cubs who did not attend received it by email). Bookings for camp will not be accepted on the usual Consent Form.

Sat 2nd Jun Joint Activity with Naxxar Scout Grp (Basic Course Rama) +LB @HQ 0830-1615hrs

Rama teamed up with Naxxar Scout Group to organize this joint activity which is part of her basic course training. All details of this activity can be found on the mini circular which Rama gave out to all cubs (or sent it by email to those who were not present) on Saturday 5th May after the Simar visit. Quick reminder: full activity uniform, packed lunch & enough drink for the day, craft bag, First Aid box (those cubs who did it for their Silver arrow) & sunblock (please also apply some before coming).

With this fun activity where animators will relate the history of Malta, Fgura & Naxxar, the cubs will attain the Local Historian badge:)
