We cannot continue to try to compensate for lost sessions in order for the cubs to be able to obtain the badges since apart from proving difficult and sometimes impossible; it is up to the cub to make sure that meetings are not lost.

During the November Church Parade, the 5 link badge members who have started attending with Troop in October will do their going up ceremony whilst we will have 8 MOBs doing their moving on ceremony with the Pack Section - 5 of them have already started attending with the Pack Section from September whilst the other 3 will conclude their moving on period in November.

Sat 2nd Nov Cookout (+LB & +MOB) + Booking for Group Winter Camp @Polverista

Parents are to get the cubs directy to the Polverista area (behind the Fgura Football Ground) where cookout sessions will be conducted and the cubs will cook their own meal.

Cubs should come with activity uniform (with cap but WITHOUT SCARF) and those who have a Cub book should get it with them. In their backpack cubs should get a small cooler bag with food to cook like burgers, sausages and nuggets together with a bun or roll if they so wish. Cubs should also get their cutlery bag with them and enough water to drink. (It is important that cubs get ONLY the amount of food they are able to eat and not for example a whole packet of frozen sausages since these can go to waste).

The cookout is a scouting session through the three arrows.

Today we have booking for the Group Winter Camp (12-15th December 2024).

Winter Camp starts on Thursday 12th December in the evening and ends on Sunday 15th early afternoon (for cubs attending full camp) and for one nighters it starts on Friday 13th for breakfast and ends after the campfire on Saturday 14th around 11pm. Exact timings and camplist will be given later to the cubs.

Cubs should get a duly signed Consent form and the fee (in a sealed envelope with the child's name) as follows:
